Applications are invited for recruitment against Cultural Quota for the following posts in Level- 2 (GP- 1900) as per prescribed format given in this Notification.

1. QUALIFICATIONS: (A) ESSENTIAL: Minimum Education Qualification

(i) Passed 12th (+2 stage) or its equivalent examination with not less than 50% marks in the aggregate for NTPC categories.

50% marks is not insisted upon in the case of SC/ST/Ex. Servicemen/ Persons with Disabilities (PWD) candidates and in case of candidates who possess qualifications higher than the essential minimum prescribed qualification.

OR

Matriculation plus Course Completed Act Apprenticeship approved by NCVT/SCVT for technical categories.

OR

Matriculation plus ITI approved by NCVT/ SCVT for technical categories.

Note : Persons if appointed to the category of Clerk-cum-Typist should acquire Typing proficiency of 30 w.p.m in English or 25 w.p.m in Hindi within a period of two years from the date of appointment and till such time their appointments to this category will be provisional.

(ii) Degree / Diploma Certificate in the relevant stream of cultural talent for which notified from a Government recognized institute.

(B) DESIRABLE:

(i) Experience in the field and performance on (AIR) All India Radio/Doordarshan etc.

(ii) Prizes won at National level.

Copy of Matriculation or its equivalent certificate from a recognized Board, **OR** the Birth Certificate should be submitted for proof of Date of Birth.

2(B). Extent of Age Relaxation:

(i) Serving Railway employees, including casual labors, who have put three years of continuous service and substitutes who had put in three years of continuous service or three years in broken spells in the Railways. Maximum Age: UR- 40 years, OBC- 43 years & SC/ST- 45 years.

(ii) Widows/Divorced women and women judicially separated but not remarried. Maximum age: UR- 35 years, OBC- 38 years, SC/ST- 40 years.

(iii) Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD): Age relaxation of 10 years in respective communities subject to production of Disability Certificate in proper format.

(iv) Ex. Servicemen: The Upper Age limit is relaxable for Ex. Servicemen upto the extent of service rendered in Defense Forces plus 3 years provided they have put in a minimum of 6 months at a stretch service. Ex. Servicemen who have already joined the Govt. Service in civilian capacity after availing the age relaxation are not eligible for such benefit.

(v) Persons who had ordinarily domiciled in the State of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from 01.01.1980 to 31.12.1989: Relaxation upto 05 years.

3.MEDICAL STANDARD: Duly selected candidates will be subjected to a medical examination by Railway Medical Authority as prescribed for the post prior to their appointment.

4.PLACE OF POSTING & TRAINING:

(i) Selected candidates can be posted at any place within the jurisdiction of NF Railway.

(ii) Selected candidates have to undergo training as prescribed for the post and will be required to execute a bond and agree to serve the Railway Administration for the minimum prescribed period.

(iii) The selected candidates will have to participate in all the cultural programmes/ competition conducted/organized by Railway Administration from time to time.

5.CONDITIONS AND PROCEDURE:

(i) Necessary testimonials concerning Cultural activities up to the date of application, along with copies of certificates regarding age, qualification, etc. – all duly self-attested should be enclosed along with the application.

(ii) Two self-addressed envelopes (size 24cm x 10cm) with Rs. 6/- postage stamp affixed on each envelope and sent along with the application. (SC/ST candidates need not send such envelopes.)

(iii) **PHOTOGRAPHS:** Three copies of recent passport size photographs duly signed on the front side top – one should be pasted on the application and two copies (also signed on top) should be clipped along with the application form.

(iv) There is no provision of community-wise reservation against Cultural quota recruitment. The selection is open to all candidates and candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC categories who apply against notification should enclose necessary certificates for upper age relaxation as admissible and future benefit of reservation subject to their appointment on the Railway as per *Annexure- 'C' for SC/ST*. OBC candidates should submit certificate that they do not belong to the 'creamy layer' as per *Annexure – 'D'*.

(v) Applications are to be made only in the specific form as given below. Items No. 1 to 10 should be filled in English only.

(vi) Candidates found suitable and appointed on the Railway shall have to undergo training as specified and applicable to the particular post.

(vii) Higher fixation of pay will not be admissible to candidates appointed against Cultural quota.

6. WHOM TO ADDRESS:

(ii) Application for post in Level- 2 (GP 1900) (in the prescribed format) with necessary enclosures should be sent **by ordinary post only** OR be dropped by hand in the APPLICATION BOX kept in the Recruitment Section, Principal Chief Personnel Officer's Office, Northeast Frontier Railway HQ, Maligaon, Guwahati.

(iii) Application must reach the proper address by **04/01/2025** at 17:30 hours on or before (Last date for candidates residing in Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Jammu & Kashmir, Lahaul & Spiti Districts, Pangi Sub-Division in Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, Lakshadweep and abroad, is **14/01/2025**).

(iv) The top of the envelope containing the application should clearly indicate **“APPLICATION AGAINST CULTURAL QUOTA FOR THE YEAR 2024-25, E. N. No. 02/2024 GP – 1900/-, Discipline- & COMMUNITY:”**

7. PAYMENT OF EXAMINATION FEE:

(i) For all candidates except those mentioned in sub-para (ii) below: Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred) only with a provision for refunding Rs. 400/- to candidates actually appearing in the written examination). The IPO should be drawn in favour of PFA/NF Railway, and payable at Maligaon Post Office, Guwahati – 781011. Candidates must write their names & full address in the IPO.

(ii) For candidates belonging to SC/ST/Ex. Servicemen/Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD), Women, Minorities and Economic Backward Classes: Rs. 250/- (Rupees Two Hundred Fifty) only with a provision for refunding the same to those who actually appear in the written examination.

(iii) 'Minority' means Muslims, Christians, Buddhists, Zoroastrians (Parsis) & Sikhs. Economically backward classes will mean those candidates whose family income is less than Rs. 50,000/- per annum. The following officials are authorized to issue income certificate for the purpose of identifying economically backward classes:

(a) District Magistrate or any other Revenue Officer up to the level of Tehsildar.

(b) Sitting MP of Lok Sabha for persons of their own constituency.

(c) BPL Card or any other certificate issued by Central Government under a recognized poverty alleviation programme or Izzat MST issued by Railways.

(d) Union Minister may also recommend for any persons from anywhere in the country.

(e) Sitting MP of Rajya Sabha for persons of the District in which the MP normally resides.

The income certificate issued by the authorities mentioned in Para - 3(iii) above must be as per format given at **Annexure-B** enclosed herewith. This will have to be issued on the letter-head of the issuing authority.

8.SCHEME FOR RECRUITMENT: (i) The candidates who apply in response to notification issued and are found eligible for consideration for appointment against Cultural Quota should be assessed on the following basis:

(ii) **There will be negative marking in the written test and 1/3rd of marks allotted for the objective type question will be deducted for every wrong answer.**

(iii) The medium for the written examination is either Hindi or English.

(iv) The minimum qualifying percentage is 40% for both Stage- I and Stage- II separately. Only on qualifying Stage- I, the candidates would be eligible for Stage- II of recruitment process.

(v) Candidates to the extent of only 5 times of the vacancies in order of merit, who have scored minimum 40% marks out of 50 marks in the written examination, shall be called for practical demonstration and marking of testimonials/prizes etc. The merit list of written examination shall be criterion for short listing.

(vi) After clearing the Stage- I and Stage- II and after recommendation of the Recruitment Committee, the candidate would be sent for medical examination at Railway Hospital as per order of merit order.

(vii) It is mandatory for such a candidate to be declared fit in the prescribed medical category, by Railway Medical Authority, as applicable for the offered post.

(viii) For Written Test, question will be objective type of multiple choice, which may include General Knowledge, General Science, General Mathematics, Knowledge of General English & Hindi Language, Professional knowledge, Reasoning and Aptitude etc. Duration for Written Test is – 60 minutes and qualifying percentage in Written Test is 40%.

(ix) Assessment of talent would be in the relevant cultural discipline, on the basis of Practical Demonstration and on the basis of Testimonials / Prizes etc.

(x) The time and venue of written examination, Practical Demonstration/document verification will be fixed by the Railways and will be intimated to the eligible candidates in due course. No request for postponement of written test/practical demonstration/document verification will be entertained under any circumstances.

9. FREE TRAVEL FACILITY: SC/ST candidates will be issued free second class railway passes (as and when admissible) to appear in the written examination or practical demonstration provided they submit valid caste certificates. All other candidates are required to appear at their own cost.

10. COMPULSORY ENCLOSURES: Self-attested photocopies of (i) Age proof certificate, (ii) Educational/technical qualification, (iii) Cultural qualification, (iv) SC/ST/OBC Certificate, (v) Event Participation Certificates & Prizes won (vi) Other qualification certificates etc. Applications shall be rejected on non-submission of enclosures / certificates.

11. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS:

(i) **The decision of the Northeast Frontier Railway Administration** in all matters relating to the eligibility, acceptance or rejection will be binding on the candidates and no enquiry or correspondence will be entertained in this connection.

(ii) Spellings of name, father's name and other details in the application form must be as per the original certificates. If any discrepancy is found, the application can be rejected at any stage of the selection.

(iii) Application without compulsory enclosures will be rejected. Applications without Annexure-C & D in original (case Certificate) wherever applicable shall be rejected.

(iv) Application which is not as per format (Annexure-A) will be rejected.

(v) Unsigned applications OR signature in block letters OR incomplete applications will be rejected.

(vi) If left hand thumb impression not affixed/blurred/smudged on the application form, the application will be rejected.

(vii) The application will be rejected if the applicants are found over aged, under aged, date of birth unfilled or wrongly filled.

(viii) IPO issued before the date of issue of this Employment Notice will not be accepted and the application will be rejected.

(ix) Candidates must write their name and address on the IPO and enclose it with the application form with one self-addressed stamped (worth Rs. 6/-) envelope (size 24x10 cm).

(x) IPO should be drawn in favour of PFA/MLG and payable at Maligaon Post Office only, otherwise application will be rejected. Cutting, erasing or overwriting on the IPO will summarily reject.

(xi) Applications received with cash/cheque/Central Recruitment Stamp OR money order will not be accepted.

(xii) Only self-attested copies may be sent with application form. Original Certificates should be produced only at the time of selection/interview.

(xiii) Selected candidates will be liable to serve on any post/department anywhere in Northeast Frontier Railway subject to training, if any so prescribed.

(xiv) Selected candidates will be required to undergo medical examination as per the prescribed norms for different posts.

(xv) Candidates already employed should submit their application through proper channel or “No Objection Certificate” from the employer should be attached.

(xvi) Candidates should provide their mobile number and e-mail address in the application form at the space provided.

(xvii) Applications not fulfilling any of the terms and conditions given in this notification shall be summarily rejected.

(xviii) Applicant should possess requisite educational and cultural qualifications on the date of submission of application.

(xix) No TA/DA/Accommodation will be given for appearing in the selection/written test etc.

(xx) For any legal dispute the jurisdiction will be of Central Administrative Tribunal/Guwahati.

12. CANVASSING: Canvassing in any form, misbehavior, misconduct on the part of the candidate is prohibited and indulgence of such practice will be viewed seriously. The candidature of such candidates will be summarily rejected and no correspondence will be entertained in the matter. The decision of the Competent Authority in the matter shall be final and cannot be questioned in any forum.
